Entries & Late Fees

ALL ENTRIES: if not received by 5PM Monday, Aug 26
will be charged a late fee. Late entries will be accepted
IF they can be accommodated .

RIDERS MAY NOT COMPETE UNLESS: 1) Entry fees paid in full (checks may be open or dated day of show and will be held. **Make checks payable K-9 SAR Support Group**),
2) Entry form is completed and signed and 3) proof of negative coggins test dated within 12 months of show & vaccination record for horses not boarded at Holly Hill Farm. **Late fees will be enforced! Late entries for DRESSAGE will be Non-Ribboned and put at the end of the schedule. They will be scored as usual and score will count towards TSDS Year End Awards but no ribbon will be presented for this show.**

Refund Policy

Entry fees will be refunded (less office fee and stall fees) IF show secretary is presented with veterinary certification for lameness or medical excuse for rider illness on or before the day of the show.

Schooling

Unsafe conduct & over crowding will NOT be tolerated.

Longeing is NOT permitted in either arena at any time.

Jumper courses may be schooled on Friday and before 8:30 AM Saturday.

Hunter courses may be schooled on Friday evening
and before 7:45 AM on Saturday.

All day warm up in the covered arena. Please limit number of horses for safety to six at one time.

Class Cancellations

“Over fence” hunter & jumper classes will be run with only one rider. “Under saddle” hunter classes must have a minimum of 3 riders. If the “under saddle” class of a hunter division is canceled then that division Championship and Reserve Championship awards are not presented. List of canceled classes can be obtained at the Secretary’s desk and will be announced.

Pet Policy

All pets must be kept on a leash (no longer than 6 feet) at all times when on the show grounds (arena, spectator area, concession, office, stabling and warm-up areas). Barking dogs must be removed! All pets are the responsibility of their owners. **KEEP YOUR DOG AWAY FROM CRATED DOGS!**
PLEASE do not approach the score boards or concession area mounted or with your horse on lead. There are children playing in this area as well as leashed dogs and this is an unsafe practice.

**Jumpers will compete in 300m x 300m Gran Prix ring!
Footing is pristine aerovated sand with grass. Fabulous!**

***** Hunter Divisions *****

Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons to be awarded.
Ribbons through sixth place awarded in all classes.

***** Dressage Divisions *****

Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons to be awarded in all divisions. Ribbons 1-6 place awarded in all classes.

To be eligible for Championship or Reserve in Dressage In Introductory Level thru Training Level Divisions, competitors must ride 3 tests of the division. In First Level & Above Divisions, competitors must ride 2 tests in that division.

Dressage Arenas

Training test 2 and above USEF tests will be ridden in a standard 20m x 60m sand arena. USEA, Introductory & possibly Training Test 1 will be ridden in a small sand arena. Show held in case of lightning but not canceled due to rain.

If there are less than 125 rides we will run a waitlist. When the number of rides reaches 125 we will add a ring! Don't delay your entry! Avoid the dreaded waitlist and let's secure that second dressage ring!

EQUITATION DIVISIONS & CLASSES

WALK TROT DIV —Open to all beginner riders (not jumped over 2' at any show). Division will consist of three classes and be judged on equitation: Walk/Trot Equitation, Walk/Trot Hunter U/S, Walk/Trot Horsemanship (Riders may be asked to demonstrate : work collectively at the walk and /or trot, halt and /or back, figure eight, 2 point or jumping position over pole(s) , and /or answer a question regarding basic horsemanship, tack, equipment and/or confirmation (USEF equitation tests) NLEA

BEGINNER EQUITATION DIV —X rails ridden at the trot or canter. Open to all riders who have not jumped 2' or higher at any show. Flat class is walk/trot/canter. NLEA Fence height 18"

SHORT / LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION DIV— Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur riders (Short; 12 yrs of age or younger, Long; amateur riders 13 yrs of age & older) who have not shown over fences 2'3" or higher at any show. Oxers are not allowed. NLEA Fence height 2'

JUNIOR EQUITATION CLASSES DIV—Open to all Junior riders. To be divided by ages. Divided 11 + Under, 12-14, 15-17 yrs of age. NLEA (Fence heights corresponds w/division)

PRE CHILD /ADULT EQUITATION DIV - Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur riders. Rider may not enter where fences are 3' or higher at this show. NLEA Fence height 2'3"

MODIFIED CHILD / ADULT EQUITATION DIV- Open to all junior and adult amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into classes with fences 3'3" or higher. NLEA Fence heights 2'6" – 2'9"

CHILD / ADULT EQUITATION DIV—Open to all junior and adult amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into classes with fences are 3'6". NLEA Fences 2'9" - 3'

JUMPER DIVISIONS

PUDDLE JUMPERS—Open to horses that do not jump over 2’6” at this show. NLEA Fence height 2’ .6-.6.5M

LEVEL 0 JUMPERS—Open to all horses and riders. NLEA Fences heights 2’3” -2’6” .70-.75M

LEVEL 1 JUMPERS —Open to all horses and riders. NLEA Fence heights 2’9”-3’ .85-.9M

LEVEL 2 JUMPERS— Open to all horses and riders. NLEA Fence heights 3’-3’3” .95-1M

LEVEL 3 JUMPERS—Open to all horses and riders . NLEA Fence heights 3’3”-3’6” .1.0-1.05M

LEVEL 4 JUMPERS—Open to all horses and riders. NLEA Fence heights 3’6”-3’9” 1.05-1.15M

JUMPER CLASSES

USEF Table 2.11.b. (**JUMP OFF ROUND CLASS**) If rider goes clean in the first round (upon an audible signal and without leaving the ring) rider starts the designated jump off course. Least faults, fastest time wins. First round may also be timed making it possible to break the ties of horses with four faults.

UESF Table 2.11.C (**POWER AND SPEED CLASS**) Rider must jump first round clean and upon crossing the finish line of the power part, timer starts and rider continues immediately to the jump off course, the speed part.

USEF Table 2.1.A (**OPTIMUM TIME / SPEED CLASS**) Optimum time is defined as 4 secs less Time Allowed for 382 yds /min. Rider closest to Optimum Time (without going over) with the least faults will prevail. Faults will be scored under Table II.

Proper Attire for all Exhibitors

Polo shirts and breeches are considered acceptable attire and not penalized for all classes. Sleeveless not allowed. All Exhibitors must comply with US Equestrian Federation, U.S.D.F. . T.S.D.S & N.L.E.A.. headgear and harness requirements when mounted.

Order of Go Hunter BE AWARE

There are several **OPEN CARD CLASSES**. These are scored as one class but at different fence heights. Warm up being the main one. This means the Judge scores all rides in this class on the same card and it remains “open” until the last entry has ridden. **IMPORTANT** you inform the Paddock Master which class course you are riding so you will not be ruled off course. **Back to back rounds are allowed. Again notify the Paddock.**

Stabling

Stalls are available on the show grounds for \$45 per night with initial bedding included. No stall reserved without payment. **STALLS WILL BE ASSIGNED BY ENTRY POSTMARK WE WILL MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO STABLE “GROUPS” TOGETHER. STALL CARDS WILL BE POSTED AND MAY NOT BE MOVED.**

STALLS FOR FRIDAY NIGHT ARE FROM 10 AM ON FRIDAY TO 6 PM ON SATURDAY. OCCUPYING STALLS AFTER 6 PM WILL BRING ANOTHER NIGHT OF CHARGES. STALLS ARE TO BE LEFT CLEAN (not stripped) ON BOTH NIGHTS!

Take out the manure, the wet shavings & the hay. PLEASE CONSIDER THIS YOUR DONATION TO THE K9 SAR. We THANK You!!!

Do NOT contact the Show Organizer or Farm Owner about stalls! **DO NOT CHANGE OR MOVE STALL CARDS OR OCCUPY STALLS WITH OTHER NAMES ON CARDS! YOU WILL BE MOVED!** STABLING CHARTS WILL BE POSTED ON FARM BULLETIN BOARD IN FRONT OF SHOW OFFICE & ENFORCED BY STABLING STEWARD!
You may however decide stall arrangements within your group!
You must always designate night of stabling on entry form!
If no designation is made then secretary will ASSUME night before YOUR competition to be reserved.

Per USEF rule G126 Junior Riders = not 18 as of Dec 1st of prior year is a junior exhibitor until Dec 1st of the current year.

BEGINNER HUNTER DIV— X rails ridden at trot or canter. Open to all horses that have not jumped 2' or higher at any show. Flat class will be walk/trot/canter NLEA Fence height 18".

SHORT / LONG STIRRUP HUNTER DIV— Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur riders (Short; 12 yrs of age or younger, Long; amateur riders 13 yrs of age & older who have not shown over fences 2'3" or higher at any show) or horses who have not shown over fences 2'3" or higher at any show. Oxers are not allowed. May cross enter into Beginner Hunter. NLEA Fence height 2'

PONY HUNTER – Open to all riders on ponies. Ponies suspected of being taller than 14h 2" max will be measured. Small, Medium or Large. NLEA Fences 2' - 2'3'

PRE CHILD ADULT HUNTER DIV —Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur riders. Rider may not enter where fences are 3' or higher at this show. NLEA Fence height 2'3".

GREEN HUNTER DIV—Open to all horses in their first three years of showing. Indicate fence ht on entry form. NLEA Fence heights 2'6", 3' and 3'3"

MODIFIED CHILD / ADULT HUNTER DIV- Open to all junior and adult amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into classes with fences 3'3" or higher. NLEA Fence heights 2'6" – 2'9"
