I hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned harmless from any and all expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to person or property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons. Hunter Outdoor Arena: Starting at 8:30 AM

In Hand Open to all riders & horses. To be shown in hand (bridle or halter, no saddle) at the walk and jog. Class to be judged on conformation, manners, and overall presentation. (Not eligible for division award).

1. Model Hunter in Hand - Geldings
2. Model Hunter in Hand - Mares

Lead Line Class Riders 10 & Under. Rider/horse presented before the judge and may be shown on a lead or independent at the walk. (Rainbow Ribbons for every rider!)

3. Lead Line

Open Walk-Trot Horse & rider to be judged on the flat at the walk and trot, both directions of the arena. No division ribbons. May **not** cross enter in Canter classes. Open to all breeds & disciplines. (Not eligible for division award).

4. Open Walk & Trot 10 & Under
5. Open Walk & Trot - 11 & Over

Open WTC Horse & rider to be judged on the flat at the walk, trot, and canter, both directions of the arena. No division ribbons. Open to all breeds & disciplines. (Not eligible for division award).

6. Open WTC 13 & Under
7. Open WTC 14 & Over

Walk & Trot Poles Division Open to all riders. May **not** cross enter in Canter classes. Riders will be expected to trot over poles followed by a walk & trot flat class.

8. Walk & Trot Poles Equitation O/F
9. Walk & Trot Poles O/F
10. Walk & Trot Poles Flat

Cross Rails 10 & Under Division Open to riders 10 & Under. Cross rails ridden at the trot or canter. Fence heights 18".

11. Cross Rails Equitation O/F 10 & Under

13. Cross Rails 10 & Under Flat

Cross Rails 11 & Over Division Open to riders 11 & Over. Cross rails ridden at the trot or canter. Fence heights 18”.

Beginner Rider Division Open to riders of all ages. Fence heights 18” (combination of cross rails and verticals).

Future Hunter Division Open to riders of all ages and green horses. Fence heights 18” (combination of cross rails and verticals).

Jumpers in Outdoor Ring 8:30 am

There will be no schooling of the jumper course

Jumper courses at each level to consist of USEF table 2.11.b, table 2.11c and table 2.1a in this order: **Riders must enter 3 classes to be eligible for Championship and Reserve Championship**

USEF Table 2.11.b. (**JUMP OFF ROUND CLASS**) If rider goes clean in the first round (upon an audible signal and without leaving the ring) rider starts the designated jump off course. Least faults, fastest time wins. First round may also be timed making it possible to break the ties of horses with four faults.

USEF Table 2.11.C (**POWER AND SPEED CLASS**) Rider must jump first round clean and upon crossing the finish line of the power part, timer starts and rider continues immediately to the jump off course, the speed part.

USEF Table 2.1.A (**OPTIMUM TIME / SPEED CLASS**) Optimum time is defined as 4 secs less Time Allowed for 382 yds /min. Rider closest to Optimum Time (and not over) with the least faults will prevail. Faults scored under Table II.

Emerson's Jumper Jackpot - Gambler's Choice: Jumps will be assigned points according to their level of difficulty. Heights from 2'6" to 3'6". Contestants to select their own route. Each jump may only be jumped twice and must be jumped in the correct direction in order for point to accrue. Time allowed 60 seconds. 50% of the Jumper Jackpot entry fee will be placed in the jackpot and the winner takes all.

Please collect your ribbons and prizes after your classes. We cannot be responsible for ribbons not collected.

Your entry must be accompanied by a negative coggins dated within one year of show on all horses NOT boarded at Holly Hill.
